Re: Arrest of Bryan Coorey

The Hampton Police announce the arrest of 33 year old, Bryan Coorey of Hampton, NH for Disobeying an Officer, Reckless Operation, Resisting Arrest, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, Driving After Revocation or Suspension, Possession of Controlled/Narcotic Drugs, Reckless Conduct, and Fugitive From Justice.

On March 10, 2017 the Hampton Police Department received a request from the Massachusetts State Police to stop and identify the operator of a 2009 Ford Taurus that fled from a motor vehicle stop in Massachusetts. The driver of the vehicle is believed to have struck the Trooper with the vehicle as he fled.

A short time after Hampton Officers observed this vehicle in the area of Dunvegan Woods Drive. An Officer attempted to stop the vehicle at which point the driver rapidly accelerated the vehicle in an attempt to evade the officer and shortly thereafter fled on foot from the vehicle. The Officer caught up with the suspect, Bryan Coorey, and after a brief struggle was able to take him into custody.

Coorey was charged with Disobeying an Officer for attempting to evade police, Resisting Arrest for physically interfering with the arrest, Possession of Controlled Drug believed to be crystal methamphetamine, Reckless Conduct for placing others in danger while operating a motor vehicle in an unsafe manner, Operating After Suspension, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, and Fugitive From Justice for the crime of Possession of Class B Drugs with Intent to Distribute in the State of Massachusetts.

Coorey is being held on \$25,000 cash on the Fugitive from Justice charge and \$25,000 cash on all other charges.
