Re: Two Arrests for Criminal Threatening with a Deadly Weapon

**HAMPTON, NH-** The Hampton Police Department announces the arrest of two people for criminal threatening.

On May 12, 2021, The Hampton Police Department was dispatched to the area of Ashworth Avenue for a report of Criminal Threatening. Upon arrival on scene, officers were told that a female suspect had allegedly threatened a male by received a description of the alleged female suspect. The female was later identified as:

**BRITTANY CHAMPOUX, 21  
Hampton, NH**

It was reported to officers that Champoux yelled to the male victim, who was unknown to her, and flashed what appeared to be a firearm to him while making threats that lead the victim to believe that he would be shot. A description of Champoux was put out to other officers in the area.

Officers quickly found Champoux near the scene. Officer quickly recovered a BB gun that looked identical to a real handgun that was in Champoux's possession.

As a result of their investigation, officers developed probable cause to arrest Champoux on a Felony count of Criminal Threatening with a Deadly Weapon. She was transported to the Rockingham County Jail on a No Bail, Preventative Detention status. Her arraignment was scheduled for May 13, 2021 at the Rockingham County Superior Court.

As officers were conducting their investigation on Ashworth Avenue, they were approached by a witness who stated that they had just seen two men in argument and that one of the men pulled out a knife. The witness gave a description and officers immediately observed two men who fit the description of involved parties. One of the men was identified as:

During a safety pat-down, officers found a large fixed-blade knife on Ayers' person. The knife was consistent with the description given by witnesses. As a result of their investigation, officers developed probable cause to arrest Ayers on three counts of Criminal Threatening with a Deadly Weapon. It is alleged that there were three victims in this case, with one being a juvenile.

Ayers was transported to the Rockingham County Jail on a No Bail, Preventative Detention status. His arraignment was scheduled for May 13, 2021 at the Rockingham County Superior Court.

Both of these cases will be prosecuted by the Rockingham County Attorney's Office.

There were no injuries reported in either of these cases.
