Re: Burglary Arrest

On Thursday August 6, 2020 at approximately 3:30am the Hampton Police responded to 9 Bradford Ave for a report of a Burglary that had just occurred. Police determined that some electronics and personal belongings were stolen from the property. The suspects in this case fled the scene shortly before police arrived.

On Friday August 7, 2020 police identified the suspects in the case at 409 Ocean Blvd and also located the property taken from the Burglary. The suspects were identified as;

Derek Marlow, 19 years old, from Springfield, MA

Jose Figueroa, 26 years old, from Springfield, MA

Allen Carter, 48 years old, from Springfield, MA

All three suspects were placed under arrest for Burglary as a Class A Felony for entering an occupied dwelling at night while not being privileged to enter. Mr. Marlow was also charged with Resisting Arrest for failing to comply with the officers attempting to affect the arrest. All three subjects have been released on bail. This case has been referred to the Rockingham County Attorney's Office.
