Re: Assault Arrests

The Hampton Police announce the arrests of 34 year old Shawn Riley of Plant City, Florida for First Degree Assault and 46 year old Samuel Bullock from Midlothian, Virginia for Simple Assault.

On Sunday October 8th at about 5:45 pm the Hampton Police responded to 11 A Street for a report of a fight between two male subjects. The subjects were separated by the time Officers arrived on scene. It was determined that both subjects, Riley and Bullock, engaged into a physical altercation with one another.

Police allege that during the altercation Riley gained access to a tire iron and struck Bullock in the head causing non-life threatening injuries.

Riley was arrested for First Degree Assault for causing bodily injury by means of a deadly weapon. Riley was released on \$1000 cash/\$10,000 Personal Recognizance. This case is currently being handled by the Rockingham County Attorney's Office.

Bullock was arrested for Simple Assault for causing unprivileged physical conduct with Riley. Bullock was released on \$2500 Personal Recognizance and is scheduled for arraignment on December 12th 2017 at the 10th Circuit Court in Seabrook.
