Re: Arrest of Roy McNair

The Hampton Police announce the arrest of 35 year old Roy McNair of Gilmington, NH for the charge of Robbery.

On July 15<sup>th</sup> at approximately 3:00pm the Hampton Police responded to a store front at 83 Ocean Blvd for an abandoned 911 call. Police arrived on scene and determined that a man had been confronted by an employee of the shop for shoplifting. Police allege that the man, later identified as McNair assaulted the employee by repeatedly striking him in the head with his fist after being confronted by the employee. McNair fled the scene prior to police arrival. The victim in the case sustained minor injury.

McNair was located a short distance from the scene by an officer and taken into custody without further incident. McNair was charged with a Class B Felony charge of Robbery. It was also determined that McNair was on Parole out of the State of New Hampshire.

McNair was arraigned on July 17<sup>th</sup> by video at the 10th Circuit-Seabrook District Court. He was ordered held on \$25,000 cash bail and is scheduled for a probable cause hearing on July 27<sup>th</sup> at 1:00 pm. McNair remains in custody at the Rockingham County Jail.
