Re: DWI arrest following accident involving a Pedestrian

The Hampton Police announce the arrest of 54 year old Sean Conyngham from Hampton, NH for Driving Under the Influence of Drugs or Liquor and Failure to Yield to a Pedestrian.

At approximately 9 PM on Sunday August 19th an Officer came upon a person on the ground in the area of Ocean Blvd. and 6th St. It was determined that the pedestrian had been struck by a motor vehicle while crossing Ocean Blvd. in a crosswalk.

The driver of the motor vehicle remained at the scene and police determined that the driver did operate a motor vehicle while impaired. The driver was identified as Sean Conyngham. He was arrested for Driving Under the Influence of Drugs or Liquor (Misdemeanor) and Failure to Yield to a Pedestrian.

The pedestrian was transported to Portsmouth Regional Hospital for non-life threatening injuries.

Conyngham was released on \$1000 PR Bail and is scheduled for an arraignment on 09/11/2018 at the 10th Circuit District Court in Seabrook, NH.
