Re: Arrest for Firearm Discharge on L Street

HAMPTON, NH- The Hampton Police Department has arrested and charged a Seabrook, NH man for multiple offenses stemming from an incident involving a firearm discharge on L Street in Hampton. On January 6, 2021 at approximately 12:06am, the department received a call for shots fired in the area of L Street.

Upon arrival, officers quickly learned that after a verbal altercation, a man shot one round from a pistol in the middle of the roadway. A description of the man was put out to responding officers. Seconds later, a responding officer located a man matching the description as he was walking north on Ocean Boulevard near I Street. The man was identified as:

**TIMOTHY HEALD, 43
Seabrook, NH**

Based on their investigation, Officers took Mr. Heald into custody and evidence of the crime that had been disposed of inside of a nearby vending machine. Further investigation revealed that Mr. Heald was a convicted felon. A knife was also found on Mr. Heald's person.

Mr. Heald was subsequently charged with a Class B Felony charge alleging Reckless Conduct, a Class B Felony charge alleging Felon in Possession of a Dangerous Weapon, and a Class B Felony Charge alleging Falsifying Physical Evidence.

Mr. Heald was held on a "No Bail" status and is scheduled for arraignment in the Rockingham County Superior Court on January 6, 2021.

There were no injuries reported in this incident. The Hampton Police Department was assisted in this investigation by the NH State Police. The case remains actively under investigation and further charges may be forthcoming.
