Re: Serious Motor Vehicle Accident

On Saturday October 3, 2020 at approximately 10:40 pm the Hampton Police responded to a motor vehicle crash at 100 Drakeside Rd. The crash was determined to be a single vehicle accident involving a grey Dodge Charger operated by 25 year old Nathan Singh from Hampton, NH.

The vehicle was traveling west on Drakeside Rd when Mr. Singh lost control of the vehicle resulting in the vehicle rolling over across the roadway and into the wooded area. Two passengers were in the vehicle at the time of the crash. One passenger sustained minor injuries and a second passenger sustained serious bodily injury. Drakeside Rd. was closed for approximately 2 hours.

Mr. Singh was arrested for Aggravated Driving While Intoxicated (Felony), and Reckless Operation for driving at excessive speed.

Mr. Singh was released on bail. This case is being prosecuted by the Rockingham County Attorney's Office.

The Hampton Police were assisted at the scene by Hampton Fire/Rescue and the North Hampton Fire Department.
